

2009 Howell Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon



Aromatics including ripe cherry fruit, cola, and sweet oak mix with earth and leather – common characters of mountain Cabernet after almost two and one half years of new oak barrel aging and over 5 years of bottle aging before release. Classic Cabernet flavors of cherry, cassis, cocoa and spice are a big part of this complex, layered wine. A bright acidity plays off the flavors before the rich tannins add to the lingering finish. It's those attributes that make this a very delicious wine now but also show a youthfulness that hints at a long life of improvement with cellaring.
